

Clark Township Golf Cart Ordinance

Clark Township adopts **ordinance no. 97** allowing golf carts on village, city, township roads with the compliance of the following sub rules.

1. "Golf cart" means a vehicle designed for transportation while playing the game of golf.
2. Golf carts may not:
 - a. Operate on a state trunk highway
 - i. This subsection does not prohibit a person from crossing a state trunk line highway while operating a golf cart of a street of Clark Township using the most direct line of crossing.
 - b. Be operated by an individual under the age of 16-years old
 - c. Pass a vehicle proceeding in the same direction
 - d. Operate on a sidewalk constructed for pedestrian use, in cemeteries, beaches or non-motorized trails
 - e. Exceed the speed of 15-miles per hour.
 - f. Operate on roads or streets with a speed limit of more than 30-miles per hour, except for all roads south of M-134
 - g. Operate on roads or streets during the time period of ½ hour before sunrise or ½ hour after sunset
 - h. Transport any passengers unless equipped with seats as stated by the manufacturer for transporting passengers
3. Golf Carts must:
 - a. Comply with signal requirements to the operation of a vehicle
 - b. Ride as near to the right side of the roadway as practicable, exercising due care when passing a standing vehicle
 - c. Only operate on Clark Township roads or streets from April 1st to November 1st
 - d. Display a reflector on the rear of the vehicle
